

The Screwball Rally is a 5 day European road trip with 80 other like-minded teams, which are all raising money for charity. All the vehicles are cars or vans with a value of less than £750.

They will meet up with their fellow Screwballers in Kent on Wednesday 18th September before they head to Dover to catch the ferry across to Calais, the following morning. Each team is given one night's camping facilities in Strasbourg in France, Bern in Switzerland, Morvan in France, and Luxembourg, but with it is totally up to each team to decide how to spend their days on the road, which route to take and where to visit, before being back in Calais on 23rd September.

This year, there is the possibility to visit seven countries other than England: France, Belgium, Luxemburg, Germany and Switzerland.

Duncan says, *"Give a man an old green Saab and he'll drive round Europe with his best mate, and probably get into one or two scrapes along the way. Give a young person an education and they'll lift themselves out of poverty, develop their country and make the world a better place."*

He has therefore decided to give all donations to the David School to help the Trust continue to provide education to the community's children. With increased donations, further education will also be provided for the adults in the evenings.
